THE CELEBRATION OF PENTECOST

Recognized from Judaism to Christianity, the celebration of Pentecost on the 5th is a holy day worthy of exploration. The Jews had celebrated this day for centuries as a follow-on to the celebration of Passover. Acts 2:1-12, identifies this as an unusual day, a day of a prophetic fulfillment, a day for recognition of the Holy Spirit. We also learn that Peter's message is accepted by 3,000 people this day as they request baptism.

"OPERATION OVERLORD"

On the 6th 1944, D-Day, "Operation Overlord" in concert with "Operation Bodyguard" (the deception) codenames supporting the Battle of Normandy, moves into reality. From the fall of Dunkirk in 1940, to the numerous experiences gained in other battles, the Allies began to lay serious plans in 1943 for an invasion sometime in the upcoming year. At the Trident Conference in Washington DC, there was general agreement that a mission to invade would be best across the English Channel and that the utmost of care would be needed to maintain an element of surprise.

Resources, including marine landing-craft, airplanes and ships were in tight supply. Location of where to attack was debated. The Germans believed the most likely spot for an attack was at Pas de Calais, France. The Allies believed that Normandy provided the greatest chance for success, if they could overcome the challenge of creating an artificial harbor and do so with surprise.
