## VOTING SYSTEMS UNDER THE SPOTLIGHT

On the 20th, **49** days to the midterms, consider your election system, *should it be managed by the Federal Government or locally?*

After the 2020 election we find that the Dominion Voting Systems took on a great deal of criticism as a voting system with evidence showing that their systems lacked fidelity. By 2022 the spotlight is widening as evidence is found showing that Clear Ballot voting systems have been compromised in much of the same manner.

Where is blame to be laid, as systems are modified by State authorities, and we learn that the same auditing standards that are to be found in the private sector are not being implemented in the public voting sector.

Planes can not fly if they cannot show an audit trail for the parts used, from the origination of the metals used in the parts all the way through to the part being installed onto the plane. Yet we allow for our entire voting system to be compromised, which has a direct impact on our Republic. This Republic we call the United States of America, has stood for 240+ years, can it stand if the voting system has been compromised?

## STATES RIGHTS IN THE GOVERNMENT

On the 24th, 1789, Congress establishes a **Supreme Court**. While the Supreme court has evolved over time, remember that it was the 3rd branch to be created. Even the office of President was created ahead of the Supreme Court. Is it possible that the Supreme Court could be reorganized to reflect a different number of justices, or even a representation by geographical region? The answer is, perhaps. By 2022, we have seen a clear movement back to a recognition of "**States Rights**", meaning that states have the right to determine legislation that reflects the will of the people.
