On the 25th **Congress approves 12 amendments** and send them to the States for ratification. While the States passed 10 of the amendments, the original 2nd Second Amendment was passed 203 years later in **1992**, becoming the **27th Amendment**. Some have thought that the original 1st Amendment would not be practical to pass today, since it dealt with appropriating Congressional seats on a strict allocation of 1 seat per 50,000 citizens, for a total of 6,767 Representatives. This would be a seemingly preposterous number of House Representatives to conduct any business.
