## FIRST ABOLITIONIST SOCIETY IN AMERICA FOUNDED IN 1775

On the 14th in 1775, the First Abolitionist Society in America is founded in Philadelphia with Benjamin Franklin elected as the President. Franklin was a slave owner, yet solidly got behind the movement to promote a slave-free country. The Charter signed stated such powerful messages as *"...having pleased the Creator of the world, to make of one flesh all the children of men, it becomes them to consult and promote each other's happiness, as members of the same family ... to extend the blessings of freedom to every part of the human race... and in a more particular manner ... to freedom by the laws and constitutions of any of the United States..."*.

## THE LONGEST FILIBUSTER IN HISTORY

On the 11th in 1964, the Senate started the longest Filibuster in history, lasting a total of 60 working days, and was led by the Democrats to stop the Civil Rights Act.

## GOOD FRIDAY
